The Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) rent-a-car concessionaires (RACs) sought out the team that is now Conrac Solutions Project Delivery to develop a near-terminal ConRAC on terms agreeable to both the RACs and the City of Austin. Mark Pfeffer assembled a team that included Anchorage Rent-A-Car Center veterans Bob O’Neill, design-build construction manager, and John Steiner, project counsel for negotiation and document drafting.

The core team employed a collaborative process, working with the RACs to achieve joint decisions with the City and Airport, and to document terms in a manner satisfactory to the parties and capable of special facility bond financing. Bringing together an effective design, firm pricing and advantageous financing, the project was completed on schedule, within budget and opened to the public Oct. 1, 2015.

Since opening, part of the facility’s ground-level employee parking lot has been transitioned to a Ground Transportation Center and now provides passengers access to taxis and transportation network companies—Uber and Lyft.
